THE COLLEGE LIVERY

BHS Approved - Full range of tailored Livery options from DIY to Full Livery

Fees are scaled up from a stable / grazing / facilities / utilities cost of £35 per week, which can be used as a DIY livery price. This and all other packages include the stable, access to yard facilities and access on a shared basis to facilities at The College Equestrian Centre.

Stable management of Mucking out daily, then skipping out twice a day, changing hay nets, cleaning water and checking the horse is content is costed at £5 per day in either a five day Monday to Friday package or a seven day per week service.

As an example of prices - All plus forage & feed

DIY would cost £35, all horses to be fed at the same time by our staff

5 day mucking out with 2 bales straw (owner turns out) would cost £67.70 plus forage & feed

5 day mucking out, 1 bale easibed, turned out 3 days by us would cost £80.25 (winter) £72.75 (summer)

7 day mucking out, 1 bale easibed, turn out 4 days per week would cost £90.50 (winter)

All plus feed & forage. Easibed has been chosen as yard bedding because they claim that it will be much better value than shavings once a bed is established, and that 1 bale per week is realistic. If it does not work then we will move to shavings.

Liveries will be invoiced for their core agreed service in 12 even monthly charges, feed and bedding will be invoiced on the quantity used through the month. £35 DIY would be charged at £152 PCM

Livery includes full shared use of all facilities at The College

Trailblazers Dressage – Preliminary, Novice & Elementary Classes – Senior & Junior

JUNIORS riding ponies/horses up to 16 years of age and not to have attained their 17th birthday on the day of the Championship. (In the case of dispute, birth certificates may be called for).

All tests at 58% and over gaining qualification at that level in first rounds. In the event of a partnership ceasing the qualification ceases. Only qualified partnerships from the second round to compete at the Championships.

Horses that are currently registered with BD or horses that have been registered within the preceding 12 months will not be allowed to qualify at Preliminary level with any BD points, Novice level with more than 60 points or Elementary level with more than 100 points. Should a horse be downgraded, the points awarded will be accepted by Trailblazers.

Chiltern & Thames Rider Magazine Dressage Championship Qualification

First to qualify, does pass down the line, must achieve 58%, if over 20 entries in class a second qualifying place available. Qualification remains with the combination only, rider must be a CTR member before qualifying & declare membership number on entry

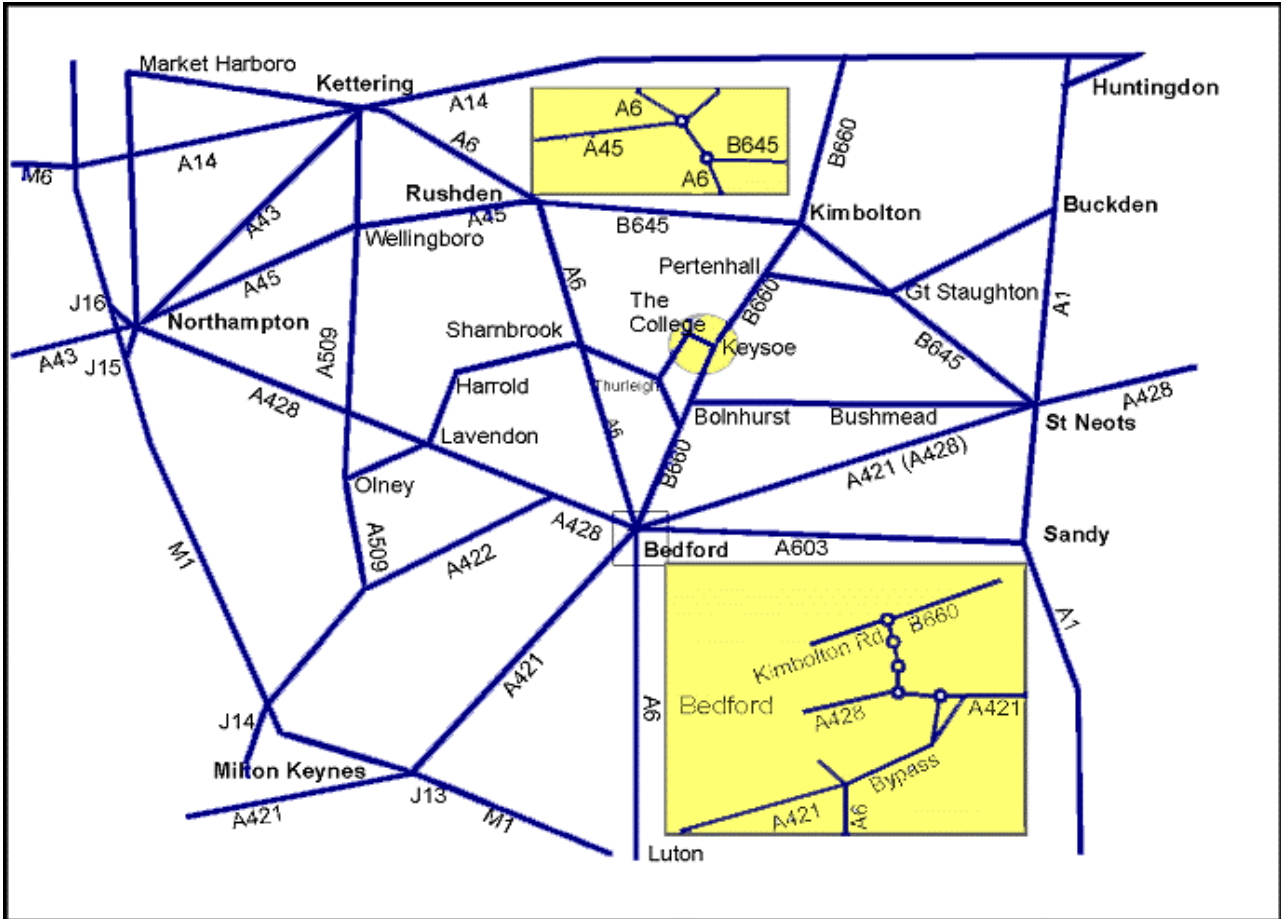

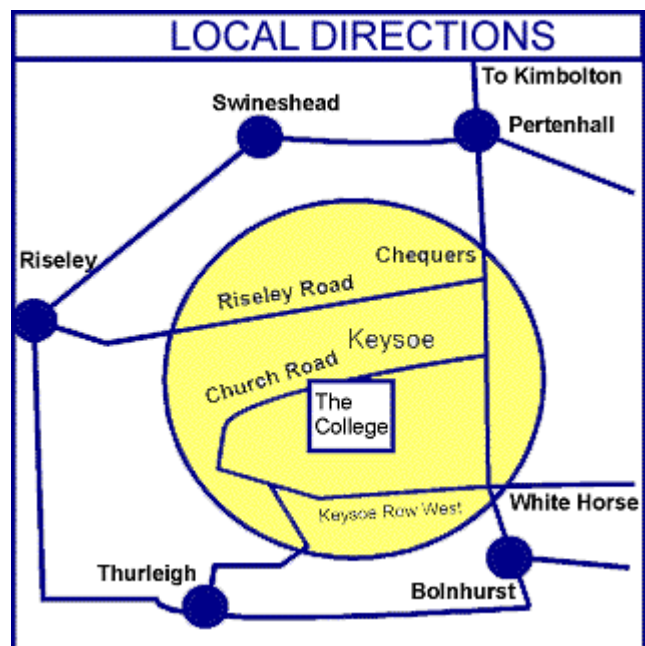
